- ✔ Works that align with our values of **connection, support, trust, respect, and collaboration**.
- ✔ Fiction and nonfiction books that foster personal growth, creativity, and thoughtful discussion.
- ✔ Children's books that encourage curiosity, confidence, and kindness.

What We Do Not Accept:

- ✘ Books with political or religious themes, agendas, or viewpoints.
- ✘ Content that is divisive, discriminatory, or misaligned with our commitment to inclusivity.
- ✘ Books that contain excessive violence, hate speech, or explicit material that does not contribute to a positive or empowering narrative.
- ✘ Self-published books that have not undergone professional editing and formatting.

Submission Process:

1. **Book & Author Information** – Provide a summary of your book, genre, and a brief author bio.
2. **Why BRB?** – Share how your book aligns with our mission and values.
3. **Availability** – Books must be available through a recognized distributor (e.g., Ingram, direct wholesale, or consignment).

4. **Quality Standards** – Books must meet professional publishing standards, including proper formatting and editing.
